You and your pastor determine the location, support levels, ministry direction, and decisions.

Our Process

- Consult with your pastor concerning God's calling.
- Complete the preliminary and full applications.
- Upon a positive application review, we will then schedule an appointment with your pastor for your interview at your home church.
- After your interview, the Executive Board will vote on your acceptance as a missionary.
- After the vote, a letter will be sent to inform you of their decision.
