Dear Pastor, Co-laborers and Friends in Christ:

As mentioned in our last letter, the Pulmonary Doctor had recommended that I have a Heart Catheterization to check the pressure on the right side of the heart and the Heart Doctor advised that I have both sides of the heart done while under going the procedure. The right side of the heart was fine (no pulmonary hypertension) but there were 4 blockages (blockages were 2 at 80%. 1 at 90.7% and 1 at 99%) on the left side. so I had 4 stints put in place. I thank the Lord for the wisdom He gave my Heart Doctor. Dr. Chandler is a born again Christian. The breathing problem continues but "Praise the Lord". I'm not bed ridden. I can no longer go any distance without having to rest but after I rest for a time my oxygen level returns to 93/94.

God is good and He has shown Himself faithful during this time. One of the lessons I have learned through all this is found in Hebrews 10:36, "For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. "I read a sermon and was impressed by the following truth. Speaking about the Foreknowledge & Sovereignty of God the Preacher stated two truths about God that. causes one to reioice. 1) The Foreknowledge of God. means that our

Heavenly Father knows from the beginning what the end will be, nothing ever takes Him by surprise. 2) An infinite, sovereign God has foreordained every minute detail of our lives from before the foundation of the world. We delight to know that nothing happens by chance. We are not creatures subject to circumstances, dependent upon luck. There is no such thing as "good luck" for the child of God. Would I like to be whole again now, of course, but I would much rather be doing the will of God. As God has promised there will be a day when I will me made whole again, "Praise His Name." We thank God for the many blessings we have received through out 2008.

We would like to close with another promise from "Our Heavenly Father", Hebrews 13:5, *Let your* conversation *be* without covetousness; *and be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.

We thank you for your friendship, prayers and faithfulness through out the years. May our "Heavenly Father continue to bless you as you continue to serve Him. We wish you a very Merry Christmas and a Prosperous New Year.
