



Dear Pastor, Co-laborers and Friends in Christ:

After 19 days they realized that there was no way they could get me back

to the 6 liters. I was discharged from the hospital under Hospice Care. Now with all that professional gloom and doom, very few of the professional people know that God is in control. I did have opportunity to talk to most of the nurses and Doctors about the fact that my life was in the hands of the Lord and they could only do what My God would allow. Pray that they will come to at least think about their own eternity.

I realize that I'm where I am, because of Gods Appointment, that I'm in His keeping, under His training and care and for His time. (Isaiah 41:10 — Fear thou not; for I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness.). We are still confident that the Lord can heal completely, if it is according to His will.
