They will fill us in on the details of their ministry so that we can carry on their work while they are on furlough. We are excited about this ministry and praise the Lord for this opportunity.

I just turned 73, and thank our dear Lord for the good health and strength He has given to Patty and me. We look forward to this endeavor, and pray that the Lord will bring many to know Christ as their Savior during our time there.

I thank God for the experience He has given me of 40+ years in the pastorate, and Patty being a former missionary, to team up and use what Christ has taught us in helping others. There are many here and overseas that do not consider where they will spend eternity. We must reach as many as we can before Christ returns.

We have enjoyed seeing many of you while stateside, and spending time with my family in North Carolina. My two sisters and I are getting up in years, and when we leave for a lengthy trip like this, we do not know whether we will see our loved ones again this side of heaven. But, we do have the joy of knowing that each one who is in Christ will be joined with Him and will forever be in His presence. Oh, what a reunion that will be!
