Canadians are now busy outside in the warmer weather. This has been evidenced in our latest distribution of PIBC Bible Study offers. We sent out 5,000 and received one reply.

A few weeks ago, the dryer, in the home of a young Sudbury couple, quit working. This caused the wife to go to the local Laundromat. On the counter she saw a newspaper (The Northern Life) and began leafing through it. When she got to the last page, her eyes fell upon the weekly ad announcing the Pilgrim Independent Baptist Church. The following Sunday, she and her husband began attending services. Since then they've been faithful and growing in the Lord. THANK YOU for giving sacrificially so that the Lord could use this ad in The Northern Life to reach out to Canadians in the Greater Sudbury area!

One of the couples, that had been attending regularly, failed to show up for several services. A newly saved man and his wife (fruit from door to door evangelization) went to visit them, shared their concern, and exhorted them to not forsake the assembling of ourselves together. The couple was back in church this past Sunday. Pray for PIBC, as this young church grows in Christ.

At Naim Centre, we're going door to door again. Many folk listen but haven't yet shown much desire for the things of the Lord. Please pray for these people that they wouldn't continue to harden their hearts against Him.
