This has been a blessing to us **financially** as we have taken the equity that was in our home in Whitefish and paid cash for the mobile home, thus reducing our monthly housing expenses. The owners of the mobile home (an elderly couple) have lived there for 15 years and have built onto it twice. We have also been able to begin ministering to them, and, as they are moving into North Bay for to be closer to the hospital and doctors, we will be able to continue ministering to them.
