What a tremendous blessing to be part of that ministry.

Several weeks ago, the Lord provided a place for us to have a baptism. The three people that accepted Christ, obeyed the Lord in believer's baptism. They continue to be faithful to the weekly services and are growing in Christ.

The couple that we had been regularly meeting with on Sunday nights, at Redbridge, has asked us not to come back. The wife still wants to continue with the devotional we give out, but the husband is having a struggle with sin, and at this point, does not have the victory over it thus causing him to make this decision. Please pray with us for this couple.

Winter is upon us and we are still trying to get the mobile home insulated properly. Under the addition, the rodents had gotten up into the insulation and had rendered it useless.
