We've been very busy since the snow left. Praise the Lord for the warmer weather.

And with the warm weather, door to door evangelization has begun once again. I've found that the folk in North Bay are more receptive than other places we've been. We've not been invited into the homes yet, but have stood many times and reasoned with the people for up to an hour at the door.

Please pray for us and our contacts as we seek to win lost souls to Christ and see their lives transformed.

The church is doing well. Our folks are beginning to go out with me distributing literature, and several men have gone with me door to door. Visitors are coming on a regular basis. Our youth have met together to prepare the gospel tracts for distribution (labeling them and folding them) and also to mow lawns for elderly folk that aren't able to do it. This gives us an open door to speak with the older folks about their soul as well as teach the youth Colossians 3:17 and Proverbs 22:1. They are the verses we've been concentrating on and learning during the past few weeks.

We now have several good Sunday School teachers and a pianist who is starting a children's choir and takes care of the music in the church.

As you already are aware, I meet with a new convert on Monday nights at Tim Horton's coffee shop. I noticed for three weeks straight, a young man in the Tim Horton parking lot. Having prayed for the opportunity to speak with him, the Lord opened up the door and we spoke briefly. The following Sunday he came to church having been invited by another young man in our church. When he came in, he was surprised to see me, the young man that invited him was surprised that we already knew each other and I was praising the Lord for His plan in getting this young man to church. Please pray for his salvation. He is very receptive to the Word of God but hasn't yet made a profession of faith in Christ.


