He goes into a home or business after it has been flooded, pumps the water out, and completely dries the flooded area. Between being ill, having to take emergency trips out of town, and working on emergency flood jobs, he hasn't been to church in weeks; but, the good news is that to meet with him tomorrow morning to continue our Bible study.

Another man comes when he is in NB. He brought his wife last Sunday, but I don't really look her to return on her own at this point.

There are two ladies who come out to the services faithfully at the Marina Point Retirement Home. We praise the Lord for them, as they are quite the encouragement. They, too, are trying to get others to attend services.

A man named John attended the service last Sunday morning and may return next week.

We're going to show the film, "Hidden Treasures", on March 27 during the P.M. service. Flyers are being sent out, and posters put up for this, as well as the giving out of personal invitations. There is a 65 year old lady who I've been witnessing to for six years that says she may attend.

Many others are being ministered to here and we ask your prayers for each and every one of these situations.
