Spring has finally sprung here in the far north, however, we're still getting snow squalls at times. But, warm temperatures are coming to stay very soon.

Since the last prayer letter, we've had one lady who has begun attending the church. She seems to have a religious background but we're uncertain as to her salvation. Please pray for this lady that she will start coming more faithful and will allow the Lord to work in her heart. I was out on the street two weeks ago and was speaking with two 11 year old boys. Last fall they stopped by the Bible / tract table we had set up and each one took some tracts and a Bible. I began speaking to them about the Scriptures and one of the boys said that he would like to learn more. I suggested that we could start a Bible study time on Thursday evening at the church to which he said that he might be interested. He called me later that evening and told me that, not only would he be interested in a Thursday evening Bible study, but a Tuesday evening Bible study as well.

We've had one session so far and we are scheduled to have another this evening. Please pray for him that he will see his need of the Saviour as we look together into the precious Word of God. Pray also that other young folk will begin coming out Tuesday and / or Thursday evenings to this Bible time.

During the month April, a young man from Tennessee came up and for several days helped out with evangelization by way of distribution and talking with folks one on one. Pray for him as he continues his studies in Tennessee and follows the Lord's leading.
