Dear Praying Friends,

With temperatures well below zero and snow blowing, winter is here. Winters are getting a bit more uncomfortable as the years go by.

During the months of October thru December, we've seen one lady baptized. It took five years, but she finally took that step. Many people came out to this event and I was able to preach the Gospel clearly and simply. Afterward I spoke with several of the visitors who exhibited some very hard hearts. One young woman, who is separated from her boyfriend and has three children, stated that she did not agree with anything that I said. Just recently she was hospitalized in Sudbury with quite a large cancerous tumor. **Please pray for her.** We're reaching out to her by means of one of her friends. There were other people that I was able to speak with after the service who are adamantly opposed to the Gospel. **Please remember these hard hearts in prayer.** Only the Lord can cause the seed, that was planted on that day, to have any effect.

Brother John, one of our trustees, has bone cancer and has been placed in a nursing home. He is bedridden for the most part but they use an overhead lift to get him out of bed, place him in a wheelchair and take him to the dining room where an assistant helps him to eat what small amount he is able to take in. We try and visit him once a month, as the care facility is five hours south of us (in good weather.) We will be going down next week to visit with him. **I'll be letting him know, once again, that you dear folk are lifting his name before our Heavenly Father.**

There have been no visible results from the distributions we've made in the area however much planting has been done. Halloween night we gave many tracks, spoke with many people, and showed our film, Death the Relentless Foe, on the outside of the church building with speakers in the parking lot. While dealing with the children, at the table we had set up, many of the parents in the vehicles saw and heard parts of the film.

We trust that you had a very merry Christmas, as we did, and were able, once again, to reach out to the multitudes with the Gospel.

We greatly appreciate your faithfulness in praying, and in providing the finances in order to do the work of the ministry here in Canada. May the Lord richly bless you in 2019 as we each serve Him.....
