Praise the Lord for the opened doors to serve him and for His touch on the lives of so many and for the precious souls that have been saved. Again we are grateful for the many hundreds of safe miles our Lord has allowed us to travel on this gospel journey. We have been from North Carolina, South Carolina, Florida, Mississippi, Georgia, Grenada W.I. (In Mississippi my defibulator knocked me off my feet again while I was preaching, wow, that thing hurts! This was my second defib hit).

I thank him that I can continue to be a part in the spreading of the gospel of Christ. The highlight of my day is when I can preach the gospel of Christ, I'm reminded everyday that it is not the energy, enthusiasm, volume, or dynamics nor any other thing about us that gets the job done, but truly the presence of the blessed Holy Ghost.
