## **Just for thought ----- Megiddo a Biblical place of interest.**

*Megiddo is located about halfway between Mt. Carmel on the west and Mt. Gilboa on the east in the triangular Plain of Esdraelon. Jesus often viewed this plain as He looked across the valley from Nazareth on the north to Megiddo on the south. The size of the plain is about 15 x 15 x 20, miles. The plain has access on the west to the Mediterranean Sea at the port of Haifa. It also has access to the Jordan Valley through the Valley of Jezreel on the east. The Pass of Megiddo gives access to the south via the Way of the Sea and across the Carmel range. To the north, the ancient route ran northeast from the plain to the Sea of Galilee and then into Syria and Mesopotamia. Therefore, Armageddon can be entered from all the points of the compass!*
