*Can you believe it? We are already into the first quarter of 2012. Yes, there is excitement in our hearts as we anticipate the coming months of service for our Lord. Of course, all this is conditional for he could call us home at any moment and then all our labors will be over. 2011 has been like water rushing under the bridge fading deeper into the past with every rushing moment of 2012 towards eternity. So like Paul of the Bible, we should forget the things of yesterday and reach for the things that rush to us from the future. This does not mean that we are forbidden to remember past blessings, but it does mean that we are not to dwell or live in the yesterday for it is gone forever. Don't reach back but reach forward. I realize I'm not the man I used to be, and I can't do what I've done before. But by the grace of God and prayers of so many people, I'll do all that I can. It's a wonderful life to serve our Savior and by the grace of God we press on. Mamie is so supportive and encouraging to this preacher. Please pray for her as she will have to double the driving and all the other things that are involved in our staying in the field of his choice for us. We are praying that this new lead in my heart will regain some of the ejection power and stop the deteriorating of it as well. One of the problems I am dealing with is the swelling of my hands and feet. I just can't seem to get rid of the fluid like I need to. I have several very early stage melanomas. One on the right ear and one on the left side of my neck that must be removed in the month of April, the Lord willing. Our Lord has been so gracious to us in allowing us to keep a pretty full schedule over these 15 years on the road. We just want to praise him with all our hearts. Looking forward to a very fruitful year, the Lord willing.
