March ended my prostate radiation treatments (38 in all) The radiation treatments leave one with great fatigue and a few other side effects, one is I had outpatient surgery on April 9th 2013. Praise the Lord we were able to keep all but one of our scheduled meetings even though we had to sit in a chair while we preached the first two weeks but as we traveled to South Carolina some of the stitches broke loose and we then had an open wound which the doctor cleaned and packed and then taught Mamie how to do it, she learned well. As of this letter it's almost healed thank the Lord. We traveled to Gulfport, Mississippi to be in the Jubilee there were a number of people that called on the Lord for salvation. This makes all the road miles joyful. It was our blessing to once again to get to preach with our dear friend Dr. Noah Frye; he is 82 years young and still going like a house afire.

At the time of this part of the letter we have just gotten back into South Carolina. We will preach here at the Galilee Baptist Church Sunday and then travel over night to Henderson North Carolina to participate Monday in a funeral of a brother we help lead to the Lord many years ago. Form Henderson to Hillsborough NC to Fruitland Park FL. This is annual family week of WWNTBM which will be at the Memorial Baptist Church of Belleview FL. Then to N.J. to Delaware back into N.C. then S.C. to be in an ordination etc.

Mamie is doing around 75% of the driving please continue your prayers for her. Praise the Lord so far she is doing well with her health with the exception of her reflux and terrible insomnia problem. She is such an asset to this ministry she is an encourager wherever we go.

Mr. Spurgeon once made a parable. He said, "There was once a tyrant who summoned one of his subjects into his presence, and ordered him to make a chain. The poor blacksmith—that was his occupation—had to go to work and forge the chain. When it was done, he brought it into the presence of the tyrant, and was ordered to take it away and make it twice the length.
