donated by BJU to LMCS.

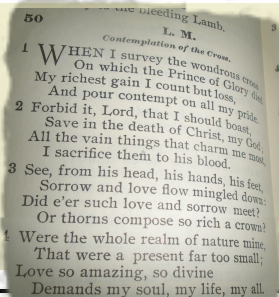
