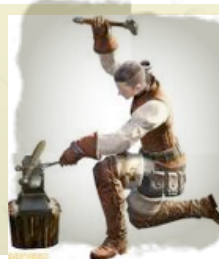
- for the LMCS teachers in Peru that began in-service training on February 6th.
