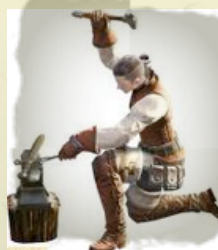

*As we were returning from our 'adventures' out West to our home in Greenville, our need to schedule more meetings on the Eastern side of the continent became more apparent. Certainly, our van and our bodies could cut back on the stress of traveling. We are on track to be in Peru within the next six months, Lord willing! We have been in frequent contact with Jeff Surret to discuss the requirements which LMCS expects of us. The spiritual needs of the students and nationals in Peru call out as in Acts 16:9. But, opportunity waits, importunity doesn't. I react as the man in Luke 11:7. Excuses abound as to why we are not yet in Peru ministering. During a meeting in June, I reminded the congregation that we have importuned them three times with our Asking, Seeking and Knocking. Perhaps you are receiving our prayer letters praying that someone else will send us to Peru. I am knocking now. We need your prayers and your help. Will you please reconsider supporting us? The blessing awaits you while souls wait for the Blessed Message. "Men always ought to pray and not lose heart."*

We are more and more burdened to see our pre-service ministry bear fruit through the preaching and teaching of the word. I am sure that God's Word does not return void. They are reviewing our case and will determine if we qualify. We are praying that their decision matches the amount which we have received in gifts. Thank you to all who have sacrificed and designated funds in this direction for us.

Rose Marie's health improves as far as the medication can take her. A doctors visit will order more blood work to determine her thyroid levels. Pray that the results indicate that she can continue with the prescription therapy. We would like to avert surgery or killing the thyroid with radiation if that would be God's will for her.

We have learned so much about ministry, about ourselves, and about the God we serve while we have been on deputation. We have faith that we could be settled and working in Peru by February 2013.
