their attention. What does poetry have to do with iron? I use poetry for my lessons in Proverbs 8:14; 20:19 24:10 and 27:17 to expand the students reading of verses in the Bible that build strong character.

Meanwhile, my attention is on teaching the fundamental precepts of God's Word to my students in class and out of class. Recently, I privately reprimanded a young boy for his problem of distracting the entire class during my lecture. The following day, he voiced his rebellion in front of the whole class. I have mentioned him to you previously in emails, and he has been in my prayers since the first week of school. The events came to a climax and a decision still needs to be made. As of the writing of this letter, he is facing expulsion. This singular incident illustrates for you my heart and desire. If he is removed, what opportunity remains for me to reach him? Have my prayers and tears for him not touched God's heart also? With tears in Paul's eyes, he told the Corinthians, "For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote unto you with many tears; not that ye should be grieved, but that ye might know the love which I have more abundantly unto you." The student has since apologized to me. I have asked his parents if I can make a home visit to him. I cannot think of a better reason to gain access into their own living room and persuade them that Jesus Christ is the only answer they will ever need to every question they ever have. You see, they need to hear the Good News. I am going to make a personal visit, with a personal invitation to have a personal relationship with a personal God through the person of Jesus Christ. I believe that is why God put him in my class. Will you please pray that the Holy Spirit will do His mighty work in the Roca family (John 16:8)?
