At the conclusion of this year, the various ministries our hands have touched, diminished. That is not to say, hearts have not been touched.

We have watched from a distance, mature believers and newly-saved believers find true solace and genuine faith to trust God, and God alone. Here are some of the blessings you have prayed for and evidences that God is faithful in every thing:



The four-year old church plant adapted to virtual services from March until November 21. Some newly announced COVID regulations began relaxing the parameters the department of health would permit for church services. In the district of Jesús Maria, in Lima, re-opening meant in the “open air”. The door was closed to use the building which has been rented for the last two years because it is not in an area where Sunday meetings are permitted. We could have opted for any other day of the week, but Sunday was definitely out for them. A previously negotiated property, which in the past was our first church plant location, was in a part of the district that permits services on Sunday, but not indoors. The first

service on November 21, was under specific protocols. In essence, we were only allowed to serve the Lord’s Supper (with an abbreviated message). ‘No singing’ was part of the protocol. We listened to the music and lyrics in silence with a song in our hearts. Fellowship afterwards was also not permitted, but, blest be the tie that binds our hearts in Christian love! We have continued open-air services now for several weeks. People walk by and often stop out of curiosity. The local security slowly drives past several times patrolling for noncompliance, and has only stopped once to confirm that we are following the protocols. Thank God we are at peace with men when our ways please the Lord. We do not sense any political or adversarial actions at his time. The door is wide open! I love Revelation 3:8

As swarms of social media posts, television interviews, and debates consume and perplex many; who would stop to read a missionary prayer letter? Who? but those who have invested in something more than news and nostalgia. Like you, we like to be kept up to date with politics that will affect how we work or minister. However, the Good News of the gospel never changes! Prayer invested is prayer amount to being things God's way.

Consider for a moment how we originally planned to serve in Peru. Our Prayer Cards had Psalm 51:13, "...then will I teach transgressors thy ways and sinner shall be converted unto thee." Should we question what God is doing, or question what we are doing for God? We find ourselves now placed in a seemingly endless State of Emergency- "**THROUGH A SUPREME DECREE**"

This *supreme decree* in Peru essentially has postponed the way we execute our original plans. But we can still be free and fulfilled under something greater than a supreme decree, we have been placed under a Divine Decree. Man's fickleness does not thwart God's plans! "So **shall** my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it **shall not return** unto me void, but it **shall** accomplish that which I please, and it **shall prosper** in the thing whereto I sent it." The apostle Paul was incarcerated and he was able to fight a good fight and finish the course God prepared for him. The faith he had was sealed and kept where no man could extract it from him.

Many would prefer to be at full liberty than to be under house arrest. Not Paul; he was no less a missionary in the jail cell than he was visiting or planting new churches. In fact, we probably would not have the Prison Epistles like *Philippians*, where Paul and Silas did not need to be released in order to share the joy of true liberty. Adversity released the song that was in their hearts.

It is highly plausible that a year ago, you would think you could never be a missionary on a foreign field (aka the USA) yet there you are. In the strange and unfamiliar culture you were born in. Your supreme commission, aka Great Commission, can no longer fall under the great omission. Win the world to Christ!

As adversity may purge ministries, so affliction may purge harbored sin. Ministry is made up of people, Ones kept for the personal expression of the gospel as it is worked out in their lives.

Is America ripe for revival, you may be asking? Are you? Can you find any area in your lives that have not been surrendered? Then, we are not ready until we ask the Lord to examine us and see if there be any wicked way in us that remains.


