## Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets

During our brief furlough that began in September to meet with supporters, we set uo a *Missions Table* to display items and bring attention to our ministry in Peru. One particular item was a tool that the fishermen in *Cerro Azul* use to mend their nets (see photo left). A net that has been caught on the rocks or frayed by sea lions bears a witness of its use.

Nets that are used are going to bear scars that you won't find on nets that are not being put to good use. They're not going to be profitable by protecting them or putting them up in a museum. Hosea 6:1-3 opened my heart: Let us, the Torn, return, healed to be rebound, and obediently follow on to know the Lord.

Our next launch begins in January; first to mend the holes in our Spanish. The past ten years, while we ministered at La Molina Christian Schools, was years full of everyday -English-use. The colloquial Spanish we could use was not practiced daily, and it was not formal Castilian. There were a lot of holes, especially for Rose Marie and myself. Most of you that are reading this update letter may recall that we came to your church, explaining the need to enroll in full time classes for professional and academic emersion of the Castilian language. Many missionaries use schools in Costa Rica, or another Spanish-favored countries, for language emersion; However, We will continue to live and cast nets in Lima until we are secure with the formal language for counseling and leading.

We ask for your prayers, and Thank-you for your encouragement through this timely, and challenging period. We know it is for the Lord's glory, when we give to Him our best. We will conclude the following itinerary before Thanksgiving.
