## They came . . . to serve.

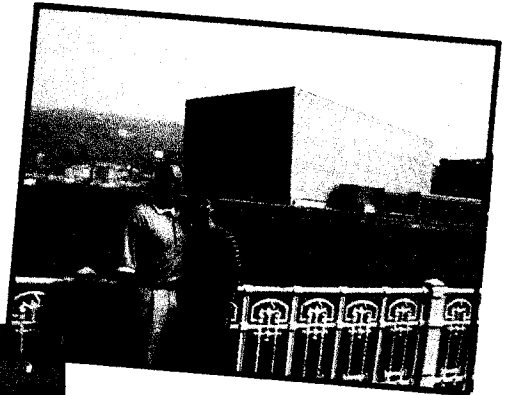
