

Postcard Text (in English)


Dear friend,

Whoever acknowledges his sinful condition, repents, and puts his faith in Jesus, will have eternal life. The Lord said, "I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:" (John 11:25)
