Finally, you may often see it called by its official name, the **Iglesia Bautista Esperanza Viva**, or Living Hope Baptist Church.

• Currently our congregation is made up mainly of single adults, with tons of "issues". However, we do have one faithful family: **Jose & Rosa Acosta**, with their three daughters, have grown much

in recent years. But the Devil has been working overtime to destroy their home and in recent weeks they have faced unusual pressures.

Would you pray for them, and especially the three girls, **Veronica (18), Paola (16), and Maria (14)**. We are finding it to be a huge challenge to see victory in our job of training Christian leadership.
