MISSIONARIES TO THE ISLAND OF POHNPEI

What a blessing to be able to witness this year our first two graduates for the Baptist Bible Institute of Pohnpei. Both gave speeches of how very thankful they were for all that they had learned during their time at BBIP. One graduate is not sure exactly what the Lord will have him to do at this time, but he continues to be very faithful and involved in his church while he awaits God's leading. The other graduate plans to return to his home island in around two months and start a Bible study which Lord willing one day will develop into a church. Two of our boys (Kody and Kaleb) and myself plan to go to the island for four days when he moves to help do what we can in that time as he begins to clear land, dig a well, build a house, etc. Our oldest boy Kyle who graduated this year from high school plans to stay for around two months to continue to work on those projects with him. The graduate will also be aided by the Peelers, another missionary couple who specialize in construction. Currently they are in the Philippines where Mr. Peeler is receiving medical attention for an infection he has in some old scar tissue. Please pray for his speedy recovery so that this trip will not have to be postponed and the work there will be able to be done.

Youth camp started this week at a nearby island. Not having much of the entertainment avenues one would have in the States, many of the teens (even lost ones) on Pohnpei look forward each year with much anticipation to go to camp. Each year the Lord has blessed and souls have been saved. Please pray that this year more souls will be saved and Christians fully surrendered to the Lord. Please also pray for all the counselors, workers, preachers, boat drivers, and cooks who give of their time to make this happen as well as safety for everyone going. I would also like to thank those of you who have donated medical supplies for the camp.

Ambassador will be having VBS a few weeks after camp and after that if the Lord works it out, we plan to take a group to the nearby island of Kosrae for about a week to help a Baptist church there with some building projects. Please also pray for safety for these things and that souls will be saved, Christians encouraged, and the cause of Christ magnified.

Lord willing, the Bible Institute will be starting a new year in August. Thank you again for all of you who contributed last year to establish a scholarship for those students who were struggling financially. We do have some money left from last year which will be used as it lasts to fund scholarships for this year.
