Thank you for your faithful support and prayers for us and our ministry here in Pohnpei, and a special thank you for those who prayed for camp this year. Many came out and many responded for salvation and for surrender to the Lord. The Sunday after camp was a special blessing to see so many attending and giving testimonies of what God had done during the week of camp. Around five young men in our community made professions of faith during camp and testified during the service. Many others also stood and shared how God had used camp to deal with areas in their lives. The time of testimonies went on for three hours and was such a blessing to see how God had worked and changed lives.

It is exciting to see these young people get involved in visitation and other church ministries. As a church we have a ministry to the jail and our first service after camp was very unusual. Instead of the usual one vehicle of people who come, we had three vehicles with around 25 people who came out to minister. It ended up that we had more from our church show up than were actually in the jail which had never happened before. Seeing so many people on fire for the Lord has truly been encouraging and we are so thankful to be a part of seeing what God is doing here.

A week after camp we had Vacation Bible School and many from camp were eager to get involved and helped in several areas. We thank the Lord for those helpers, for the \* Upcoming revival meetings at faithful teachers, and for the great group of children that attended each day.

The trip to Nukuoro that we mentioned in our last prayer letter was delayed for various reasons, but thankfully is finally scheduled to take place in a few days. The boys and I have been helping a fellow missionary couple, the Peelers, as they get things packed and ready to send down with the ship. Kody, Kaleb, and I plan to go to the island for a couple of days to help unload around 40 pallets and help as we can as they set up for their work. Our oldest son Kyle will stay for two to three months to further help with all the many projects that have to take place. Please pray for us as we go to help and those also who are going to stay and serve the Lord endeavoring to reach many people for the Lord.
