Many of you continued to stick with us even when we could not return to that field for health reasons. We thank you from the bottom of our hearts and are glad that God keeps accounts and will surely reward you for your good work for Him. As we miss the people of Pohnpei, we also will miss reporting back to your churches, but we are glad that your support can go now to those who can actively do more for the gospel of Christ. We will pray that God will lead and direct you to those next fellow laborers that you can serve with for the cause of Christ.

As a final update, we have now received the first payment for disability. There are still some issues that need to be worked out, but for the most part we are well on the way to that goal.

Christa was turned down for the recommended medication for her MS. Because of the high cost of the infusion, insurance wants to try some cheaper options first, so please pray that either the cheaper medication will work or that it will not work and that the insurance will pay for the original medication that the neurologist recommended for her.

The Lord worked it out that we had a couple put in an offer on my mom's house before we even had finished cleaning it out. Closing is set for the first part of November so, Lord willing, that will work out.

I was able to attend some of the pain management classes at the VA, but because of issues with the selling of mom's house, we plan to continue those later in November.

Thank you again for your investment into our family and the ministry to the people of Pohnpei. We look forward with anticipation to see one day in Heaven the souls saved and changed because of your obedience to the Lord in giving to missions.
