We are very busy with language study several hours every day, and slowly but surely we are seeing our understanding and ability increase. In most basic tasks of living, we can function in Khmer, and even are able to invite people to church when we hand out tracts each week. Sharing the Gospel clearly with someone from a Buddhist background is still a bit beyond our ability, but we know this is a valuable time of learning, observing, and praying. Continue to pray that God will give us His power as we study the Khmer language.

We have only been in Cambodia for 3 months, but the longer we are here, I realize that we do not have the ability, charisma, or skill to reach the Cambodian people. This does not bother me, though; I am thankful for this fact. Only God can do this work as we yield to Him.
