She told us it could potentially cause late term miscarriage, preterm labor, and/or postpartum hemorrhaging. Many of you contacted us letting us know of your prayers. This past week we had a follow up appointment. The doctor did a very thorough exam and even compared charts from my last visit. She could not find the cyst. She said she had never seen a cyst of that size "disappear." With many tears I explained how a lot of people were praying. She replied with, "Well, that's why."
