The food in Cambodia has been a big part of this adventure of adapting to a new culture. However, every once in a while, I'll be surprised by something that may not look appetizing, yet is very delicious! One of those surprises is a delicacy typically made around any big Khmer holiday called "an-sawm." It's sort of in the shape of a sushi roll, but the outside consists of sticky rice, while the inside is stuffed with a variety of meats, bean paste, or bananas. I usually choose the pork and bean paste. Most of the time it comes wrapped in banana leaves. So, I unwrap it, cut it into slices, and fry it for a few minutes on the stove. Served along with some delicious Cambodian sauce (my friends taught me to make), it is a super yummy treat for us all! I'm so thankful that one of my biggest fears before coming to Cambodia (eating their food) has even been blessed by the Lord giving me some delectable treats. 😊
