During our stay in Phnom Penh, the Lord has opened the door for me to be able to take another language class. This particular school began teaching the Khmer language after we had already moved to the province. Since that time, both Matt and I have been trying to figure out a way to get me in one of their five week courses. It "just so happened" that a class started two days after we moved here. We prayed for the Lord to work out all the details in order for me to attend and He did! It certainly is not easy being away from my children every morning of the week, but I'm so thankful for some sweet Khmer friends who are taking good care of them while I'm at school. Learning the language well enough to be able to teach someone the bible is one of my biggest goals. Will you please pray that this extra time of study will be profitable in helping with the ministry here?

Faithful Friends, Family, and Supporters,

This past month, we had a remarkable opportunity for Gospel proclamation in a small market town called Pa-ow, located about 40 miles from our home in Kampong Cham. In the course of surveying this town, which has no Christian churches of any kind, we met a Christian vendor in the market, along with her daughter, who is a senior in high school. They invited us not only to witness to friends and family members, but also to share the Gospel in the local high school! The favor of the Lord allowed us to get official approval from three levels of authorities, and we held a 2-hour seminar on Christianity at this Cambodian public school last Thursday. About 20 high school seniors attended to hear about the Bible, the true God, Jesus Christ, and salvation. Please pray that the Lord will use His Word in these young people's hearts and that we will have continued opportunity as we follow up with the folks in Pa-ow.
