Please pray that this additional paperwork will be given to us.

On a trip to the provincial capital to deal with this issue, we were able to present the provincial head of Religious Affairs with a banner of Romans 5:8 in Khmer to decorate his office. Thank God for chances to sow the seed of His Word!
