We are now in our 4th week of school for this school year. Joshua, Julie, and Judah are all studying with me in the morning for their American curriculum and Joshua and Julie study in the afternoon for their Cambodian class. Our neighbor has taught at the local elementary school for over 30 years and since the schools are still closed here due to COVID, she now teaches children at home. Both Joshua and Julie are fairly fluent in speaking the language and are now learning to read and write in Khmer, too. We are so thankful they have this opportunity to learn the language well. They continue to amaze me with their ability to do spelling, reading, and math in 2 different languages. The Lord sure has blessed us! Thank you for praying!

Many of you may recall us sharing with you the fact that in Memot, our ministry location, there is no Christian church. In our time here, however, we have learned of past Gospel efforts in this community. Unfortunately, these have ended with pastors leaving in disgrace due to various scandals. The result is that there are small groups of Christians scattered throughout this area who are for the most part without any leadership or organization. Recently God has brought us into contact with some of these folks. They are hungry for God's Word and fellowship, and the number of visitors for church services continues to grow. We are rapidly approaching the cap set by the Cambodian government for religious meetings, so please pray for wisdom as we deal with this "problem". Our hope and prayer is that this group can become the nucleus for a proper church here in Memot. We believe there is tremendous opportunity here and are excited to see how the Lord will lead.
