July turned out to be a very exciting month for us! Last month, we mentioned a young man named Sarun who had been coming to church. His initial exposure to the gospel was entirely online via Facebook and Youtube, and he had been proselytized by a cult, so he was somewhat confused when we first met him. Since then, however, he has been attending church faithfully, and when I taught on baptism, he and his cousin Sa Ra both wanted to be baptized as soon as possible! By God's grace, we held our first baptismal service on July 17 and baptized 7 people, including 3 new believers, 3 young people (including our daughter Julie!) and a man in the church who had previously only been sprinkled. At the subsequent fellowship service, we presented the group with a church covenant, which was accepted by 20 adults who joined as the founding members of the church here. We are thrilled at how the Lord is working and are so thankful for the wonderful spirit of love and unity in the group.
