We are happy to report that the church here officially has a name! The members voted to adopt the name of Good News Baptist Church of Memot District. We are now working on getting all the needed documentation ready to get the church officially recognized. Please pray that the Lord will give wisdom in this effort, and that He would give favor with the officials who have to sign off on it, especially as restrictive new guidelines for religion have been issued recently. We know that the church belongs to Jesus, that He will build it, and that devilish opposition cannot prevail.

I have been able to start visiting a man named Khna, who is disabled from a neck injury several years ago and is completely immobilized. He lives in Trabike, a nearby village where we have a weekly Bible study, and is a cousin to the main believer in Trabike. When I first met Khna, he told me that he is in too much misery to study about Jesus. Despite this, he has allowed me to continue visiting him and sharing the good news of Jesus Christ with him. Please pray that Khna will understand the gospel and accept Jesus Christ as his own Savior.

Recently the Lord has opened up some specific ministry opportunities for Nikki. Last month, she was able to participate in and speak at a Baptist missionary ladies' retreat, and on October 14-15 she will be taking a group from our church to a ladies conference, where she will also

be one of the speakers (in the Khmer language!). Please pray that God will help Nikki and use her greatly.
