Our first year in Cambodia, we devoted most of our time to language learning. For me, this time was greatly interrupted because of sickness with pregnancy. Over the years, I've been able to study the language with a variety of tutors and have made great progress with them. However, I've always bemoaned the fact that I never got to complete a full language course. When COVID brought everything online, I got the opportunity to start up those classes again. 9 years after beginning my first language class, I can officially say I have now completed a full language school course in the Khmer language! All the glory goes to the Lord for allowing me to do this. My husband and children have been such a great help in sacrificing much for this as well. My only desire in all of this has been to be able to communicate as clearly as possible with people here, so that the gospel can be known in this region of Cambodia. Thank you for your prayers!
