In early October we attended the annual Khmer Ladies Conference. This year 8 ladies from our church attended. One of my most favorite parts about these trips is the car ride to and from the conference. While this year's ride was filled with flooded roads and detours, the conversations inside the vehicle were encouraging. The church people here have always been so kind in expressing their love for their pastor and our family, but during this particular trip they were praising God that He chose to bring us specifically to Memot. "There are so many other places that would be easier for you and your family to live, but out of all those places in the world, God brought you to us. We're so thankful." All of us were tearful with thankfulness of what God has done here. May He get the glory for it all!

I met Vuthy last spring while distributing tracts in a nearby village. He was orphaned by the Khmer Rouge and was sent to work at the Memot Rubber Plantation after being raised in a state orphanage.
