It has been an amazing two months! We were tested in ways we have not been tested before and we were able to see God work and provide. It is great to be in the center of God's will. September 1st we left on a six week long group of meetings taking us from North Carolina, Kansas, New Mexico, Arizona, and California. We traveled over 7,000 miles, visited sixteen different churches, and attended three Missions Conferences. We made many new friends and were able to get reacquainted with several from the past. We praise God for His protection and blessing during the long trip!

We were able to use our 6x12 converted cargo trailer for our trip to California. It has a bunk bed for the kids, a full-size bed for my wife and me, and a kitchen in the back. We spent sixteen nights camping at state and national parks around the southern United States. The van worked very well and we had only one issue while towing the trailer but God provided!

I will be the first to say that there were challenging times the last two months; times when you did not know what God was going to do, times when things did not make sense, and times when you just need to see God work. There were several times when God provided a place for us to stay, one for almost a week, at no cost. There was also the issue with the van. The best I could determine was that we might have a leak in the power steering system. We did not have the money to repair or replace it and I did not have any of the tools I would need to do it myself. The only thing we could do was topping off the fluid and we prayed as a family that God would take care of the van. He did, and we have not had another issue with it since.

We are so thankful for the churches that have partnered with us in reaching Enumclaw, Washington, for Christ. We have heard from two more churches and are now at 6% of our needed support. Our prayer is to be at 10% by the end of the year. We would appreciate your prayers toward that end.
