In the last letter, we asked for prayer concerning Allen and his transitioning back into meetings. Overall, Allen has done very well, and we praise the Lord for all the new friends that he has made in the last month. Please continue to pray for Allen's schooling, however. We continue to homeschool him, and it is becoming more and more evident the struggles he has recalling even the most basic information. Pray for our patience as we teach him.

Some of you are aware of different medical things that have been developing with our daughter, Artiss. Since birth, she has had both swallowing and eyesight issues. We had an eye appointment this month, and we were told that we needed to change her course of treatment for her eyes. She is getting a new, much more aggressive glasses prescription as a temporary fix, and her eye doctor has put us in contact with a specialist in St. Louis to discuss experimental surgery. We do not know what God's will is on all of this and would appreciate your prays as we talk to this specialist in the coming weeks.

Artiss also has been referred to a specialist in Jacksonville, FL, concerning her swallowing issues. Through different tests in October, the doctors have confirmed that she is choking on many foods as she is swallowing them. Monday, November 16th, she will have a procedure to hopefully help with this issue.
