As I write this letter, we are in Washington. I wish I could say that we were here permanently, but that will be in the future. You may remember from our last letter that I shared how God had opened a door for us to fill in for a pastor in the Seattle area. It has been a joy to be in Washington again. We visited the church where God confirmed in our hearts that he wanted us in Enumclaw. We met with some of the other Independent Baptist pastors in the greater Seattle area and have begun to learn the culture of the Pacific Northwest. I look forward to being here permanently.

While we have been in Washington, a number of people have personally received a gospel tract and some have heard the full plan of Salvation. Please pray that they will make decisions for Christ.

Thank you to everyone who prayed for Artiss and her eye appointments in St. Louis, MO. We spent several days in and out of the children's hospital there meeting with different eye doctors to determine Artiss' eligibility for eye surgery. This surgery would greatly improve her vision. The doctors determined that Artiss is a candidate for the surgery as well as two additional surgeries. The first possible surgery date is in early November. Please pray that we will know God's will in this matter. Not only did God work everything out with the hospital and doctors, but he also allowed us to meet some great people at Amazing Grace Baptist Church in St. Charles, MO. They allowed us to park our trailer and took care of us so well!

We had meetings in South Carolina, Tennessee, and several in Florida before loading up and leaving for Washington in early June. We are also praising God for four new supporting churches since our last update letter! **We are now at 31% of our total needed support**.
