Most of our attendees live very close to us, and we need a place that is also nearby. We also knew we could not afford to pay the rent that different possible locations require. After much prayer, we decided to offer our community center about 30% of the rental price. Hallelujah, the Mayor and City Council accepted! Having a building for Sunday morning services is a powerful representation of The Mighty God we serve. This is just one example over the last year of The Mighty God providing more than I could ask or think!

The Everlasting Father: As God works, hearts are softened to His truth, and people call out to Him to be their "Everlasting Father." Being part of God working in people's lives is amazing. **Six individuals have trusted Christ as their Lord and Savior this past year!** Six precious souls that had no hope have a hope that will never fade; they are so excited about it. We are excited too! Excited to continue the work and watch God give the increase. There are so many more that need our Everlasting Father.




