Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

April - June 2026

God has continued to work in very evident ways over the last several months, and we are so thankful to be able to serve Him here in Washington. Some days are hard physically, mentally, and even spiritually, but there is nothing more rewarding and sustaining than God proving time and time again that we are in the center of His will.

Resurrection Sunday was a highlight for us this year. Not only was it special because of celebrating Christ's resurrection, but two people trusted Christ to be their payment for sin over that weekend. First was Tyrone, a man who lives in a care home in the area. We have been having once-a-month services there for a few months now, and the Saturday before Easter he trusted Christ! The second person to trust Christ was Rhett. God brought his family into our lives during the December floods. Rebellious and resistant to his family attending our church, what a neat transformation to watch God work in His heart, week after week. Rhett accepted God's gift of redemption Easter Sunday. Afterwards, he said through tears, "Pastor, I feel God here in church today!"

For the first time since we arrived in Washington, we had the privilege of joining our missions family for their yearly "Family Fellowship Week" at a camp in North Carolina this past April. It was relaxing, spiritually refreshing, and encouraging to fellowship with other missionaries and pastors. As part of the trip, I was asked to preach at a church on a Sunday. This was the first time we, as a family, had all been away from Mountain Light Baptist Church for a Sunday. We planned; church people volunteered to lead singing, open in prayer, and even teach Kid's Church, and I recorded a video sermon to be played during the service. It was wonderful to have our people step-up so the service could go on. Looking back on it now, that was the starting point for several people's ongoing involvement in the church's day-to-day ministry!

Another highlight of the last several months was having a group with us from Wings Bearing Precious Seed. Their main reason for being in our area was to distribute John and Romans in Seattle during the FIFA soccer games being held there this year. Their secondary purpose was to help us canvass areas of our community. Between their 15 people and our church, over 7,000 John and Romans were distributed to doors in our community. We continue to have people reach out or stop by a service because of their work.

June was "CIA" or "Children in Action" month. Every service in June, children from our church were involved in some way in the service. I worked with our young men to prepare 5-minute sermons to preach before the main sermon: Shiloh (the first salvation under our ministry), Rhett (the newest believer), and Allen all did a wonderful job sharing what God had shown them from His word.

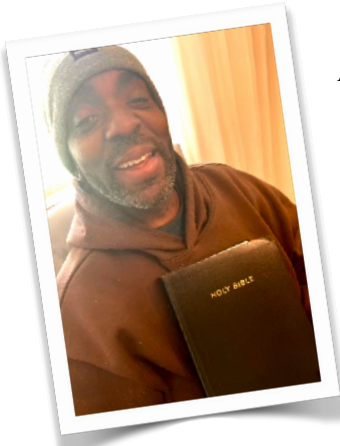

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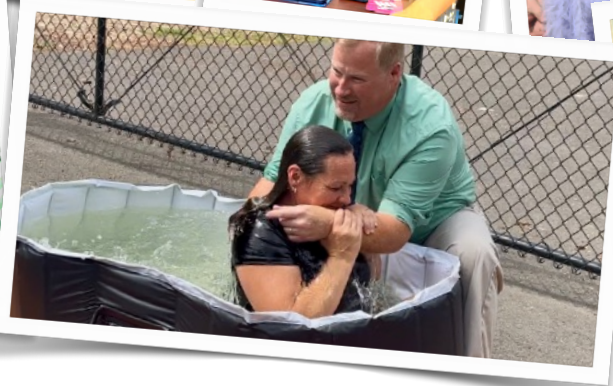

Lastly, I am privileged to share about one more soul who is on her way to heaven. My wife met Ashley, a cashier at Walmart. Ashley was in a bad way emotionally. She was able to provide for herself, but it seemed like everything else in her life was going wrong. Over the next few weeks, Ashley would spend her days off with Amiee. Ashley had some knowledge of God, but it was so distorted by false doctrine. After hours of one-on-one and weeks of being part of the Ladies' Bible Study, Ashley realized that she could indeed trust God to be her Saviour. Ashley trusted Christ in June, and I had the privilege of baptizing her on July 12th. Please pray for Ashley; she is currently in another state on business, but she and my wife keep in contact. She is growing spiritually and is eager for God to bring her back to WA.
