



Our Newest Prayer Letter

Dear Pastors, Friends, & Family,

March 2017

We have been staying busy again this month. During the first year and a half of deputation, my family and I were never apart, and we had not flown to any of our meetings. However, in a span of five or six weeks, I have been away from my family for three of those weeks, and I have been on sixteen different flights (Sam, my youngest, was on two of those with me). We are now back in the south; we have been able to see our pastor and my parents a couple of times between meetings.

Our town, Albany, GA, was hit hard by tornadoes over the last month or so. Several people in our church lost their homes. One elderly couple in our church was affected by both storms that came through and were without power several days. My boys and I were able to go over and help get their yard cleaned up some; I think it's important to teach our kids to work hard and to help others. All four of us were also able to help serve in a distribution center that our church set up in the gym. Tornado victims came to get clothes, food, and anything they needed.

As far as deputation is concerned, we are currently at 60% of our support level. This is behind where we need to be to leave in July; after much prayer and having talks to our pastor, we have decided that it is best to add three months and extend our deputation through September. We will mainly try to stay in the south through the remainder of our deputation (although we do have a couple weeks scheduled in Indiana and Michigan); we will need to be around Florida to get our visas.
