As you will recall, Joe was able to turn our church and ministry over to a Canadian. While we are on furlough, we are seeking our Lord’s will concerning our next place of service. Please pray earnestly with us about this next step in our ministry. We want to finish our course according to His will.

It is hard to believe that we have been missionaries for over twenty-one years. This was possible only because of your faithfulness to pray and to give financially so that we could stay on the field. Your prayers are needed now more than ever as we travel the many miles necessary to report to you and to seek our Lord’s will for the future!
