paper pile, and the wait time from there is usually around 10-12 months. So I guess I'll just have to wait and see what happens! And at this point, that's about all I can do! So please pray that all will work out in God's perfect will and timing. I have peace knowing that whatever happens, God is always in complete control! I'm so glad that I can rest in Himtrusting Him to meet each need in the way that He deems best.

At this time, there are a couple of other missionary families in Scandinavia that are also waiting and praying that their visas will be re-

newed. Please keep them in your prayers as well!

And please pray for a couple of other families who are currently planning and preparing to serve the Lord in Sweden. They understandably want to know what the process and timing is for getting into the country. At this point, with the way things keep changing and with the way things are just so up in the air, it's really hard to know what to tell them. Please pray for wisdom and direction. I'm praying that somehow through the process I'm in now, it may at least provide some answers for others both at

this time and in the future!

Please pray that God will keep the doors open for missionaries here in Scandinavia. The need is so great!
