This month, there were a few setbacks with obtaining my needed medications for health issues, but I am still moving forward and doing better overall. Though I still have some allergic reactions, they are now much more controlled. I am truly excited to see God's provision and healing power throughout the obstacles.

During November, I have had several great deputation meetings. One church has committed to begin supporting me financially on a monthly basis. At a meeting in Pennsylvania, I was greatly encouraged by a group of upper elementary children that loved learning about Grenada and expressed interest in missionary work. Please pray that these young people will surrender to following God's will for their lives. Visiting a church in Kentucky was also a huge blessing!
