They will also be building a fence around the schoolyard so the children will have a suitable location for outdoor activities. Please pray for wisdom, finances, and safety of those taking part!

Please pray as I raise funds for a personal vehicle. My desire is to have reliable transportation to and from the academy each day. This will also help me be available to increase my ministry opportunities and productivity. I am needing an additional \$4,000 (minimum) to acquire a vehicle and required car insurance.
