November has been an exciting month as our primary school is well-underway. I am enjoying a weekly teaching of art, assembly, and physical education for all the children, and teaching my kindergarten class. The students are excited about learning, though face challenges as our academics require much more of a workload than the average Grenadian school. The students have been teaching me about Grenadian culture, patience, and being an effective teacher.

Please pray as we endeavor to expand our church building to include a new wing specifically to provide enough space to add additional classrooms, grades, and even a preschool this next year. We have spoken with individuals wanting to send their children to the school and several national teachers desiring to work with us. The estimated costs involved will be in excess of \$15,000 USD.

Please pray that the Illinois DMV will issue my renewed driver's license, applied for in July. Without it, I cannot obtain a temporary or permanent driver's license here in Grenada. My vehicle fund has almost enough for the purchase of a used mode of transport, which is a huge answer to prayer.

With some current medical issues relating to my mast cell disorder, God has shown His provision and grace. God provided for some much-needed supplements to help with this, but please pray that the symptoms would subside quickly and for strength each day.

Though the needs in our ministry are immense, we serve an omnipotent Savior that will provide in His perfect timing. Have a truly blessed Thanksgiving and know that I am grateful for your impact in my life, Grenada, and worldwide missions.
