Dear Friends and Co-Laborers,

In April we were able to make our trip to the Midwest to visit some of the schools we have previously visited. After she completes her training in nursing, her intention is to return to Majuro to serve among her own people. That night Maranatha's music department was putting on the program "You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown." (They did a GREAT job!) We bought tickets to see it, and when we got to our seats, guess what - Nola had the seat right next to Marvina! Coincidence? I think not. We believe the Lord just gave us the extra hours to visit with our Marshallese "daughter."

Also on the trip we were able to speak in two churches and visit with all three of our children and their families. We were also able to contact another fundamental Christian college I had not previously known except by name. I hope to pursue this at a later date.

Next week we expect to be in North Carolina for our annual mission board "Fellowship Week." Then in July we will be at the Sword of the Lord Conference in North Carolina to again represent World Wide New Testament Baptist Missions. As other opportunities present themselves, we plan to continue to avail ourselves of them.

To all of you, thank you once again. You are a real blessing to us!
