Dear Friends and Co-Laborers,

We would like to touch base with you all and bring you up to date on several matters. We talked to the Buck family last week about the situation in Majuro. In 2014 there were, we understand, about 14-15 students who graduated from Majuro Baptist Christian Academy. Several are here in the United States in Christian colleges and several in Harvest Baptist Bible College in Guam. The total of the students in the school was about 360. A number of outreach programs to reach the Marshallese people are from time to time under way, not only in Majuro but on the island of Arno. Stephen and Jessica Kopp, graduates of Bob Jones University, are now serving as principal and teacher at Majuro Baptist Christian Academy.

As we continue with Solid Rock Baptist Church, the church seems to be going well. The unity of the group is a real blessing. We are still meeting in the Plains Elementary School in Timberville, Virginia. We're asking the Lord for a permanent building in His time. Earlier this month in our quarterly business meeting, the church voted to begin our missionary program by approving three missionary projects. These include Abraham Ram Lian Uk, a national missionary with World Wide New Testament Baptist Missions. We have known him for several years and he is doing a good work in Myanmar (formerly Burma). We look forward shortly to begin Faith Promise to increase our potential for missions. In the next several months we have scheduled more missionaries to come and present their work. Solid Rock now averages about 60 on Sunday morning and somewhat less Sunday evening and Wednesday night. Most Sunday mornings we also have visitors including some unsaved.

We want to extend to you our deep appreciation for your support throughout the years. Be assured that your investment in Majuro and in other parts of the world will continue to bear fruit in ways we may now only imagine. In eternity we trust to know the extent of your returns on that investment. May God bless you all!
